“El Toro’s Recycled Runways Leave Legacy and Cash Prizes”

Irvine, Calif. - Recycled Materials Company (RMC) of California launches an online contest at www.RecycleElToro.com on Friday, February 2, 2007, offering cash prizes, personal recognition and more to the individual who can “*Name That Stone*”. The winner will submit the most creative name for the large stackable concrete landscape stone resulting from El Toro Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) runways which will be broken and re-used in many areas of the El Toro re-development.

Enter the “*Name That Stone*” contest online only at www.RecycleElToro.com. The contest begins Friday, February 2, 2007 and ends on Friday, March 2, 2007. The winner will be announced on April 2, 2007 at www.RecycleElToro.com. Contest entrants can be added to RMC of California’s web alert system to receive e-mail updates about the recycling of El Toro MCAS which will include opportunities to purchase or win unique “*Piece of El Toro*” displays containing remnants of the runways.

Following announcement of the “*Name That Stone*” contest winner, www.RecycleElToro.com will serve as an information source regarding the progress and process of recycling the runways, taxiways, streets and building foundations at El Toro MCAS. RMC of California will remove and recycle 3.5 million tons of concrete and asphalt to be re-used on-site. The recycle process may take eight years to complete. Sustainability is a key goal of this re-development project. All materials will be re-used on-site by the developer and Orange County Great Park (OCGP) for private development projects including homes and various commercial sites.
